

Student Expresses Suicidal Thoughts

Active Suicidal Ideation: If a student expresses any ONE of the following, stay with the student and call LUPD (on-campus) x3434 or 911 (off-campus)

- Intent: e.g. "I am going to kill myself"
- Plan: e.g. "I'm going to take a bunch of pills."
- Means: e.g. "I know the combo to my dad's gun safe."

Passive Suicidal Ideation: fleeting thoughts or feelings without intent, plan or means

- "I don't want to be here anymore".
- "I want to die".
- "I wish a truck would hit me".

NOTE: IF A STUDENT REPORTS ACTIVE SUICIDAL IDEATION CALL LUPD AT x3434 (ON-CAMPUS) OR 911 (OFF-CAMPUS) IMMEDIATELY AND STAY WITH THE STUDENT

If it is passive or you do not know...

The student contacted you via email, text, or over the phone and you are NOT with the student

You are with the student

Is it between the hours of 8:30am-4:45pm?

2. Reply to student:
a) Give them information for the counselor on-call: (504-865-3835, press 1)
b) Suggest they make an appointment with the UCC
3. Follow up with the student next time you see them in person.

Call the UCC 504-865-3835 and press 1 to speak with counselor on-call

Stay with student while he/she calls the UCC (504-865-3835) to schedule a crisis appointment or to speak immediately with the counselor on-call.
